Ever wonder what millions of Haitian children would say that they want for Christmas?


Sadly, many Haitian children couldn't even write out a Christmas Wish List as only 50% of the 4 million children living in Haiti are able to go to school.

Considering that **90% of Haitian children do not have electricity**, I would suspect that millions of them would ask for the gift of electricity in their homes; if they even have a home.

Or, perhaps they would add to their wish list access to proper sanitation facilities. 80% of Haitian children live without such facilities leaving them vulnerable to the spread of sickness and disease.

Since only 1 out of every 4 Haitians living in urban Haiti have access to safe, clean drinking water while this changes to only 1 out of 2 for rural living Haitians, I am confident that millions of Haitian children would hope for the gift of clean drinking water.

Freedom. There is little doubt that all of the 300 000 Haitian children trapped in child slavery would list freedom on their Christmas Wish List.
